

Please join us at Tabernacle Church of Norfolk as we formally welcome Dr. Kevin Newman into the role of President at Faith Bible College!



How can you spiritually grow this Fall? Consider what FBC has to offer! Here's a very brief synopsis of what is available to you.

Unlocking the Bible takes you through God's redemptive plan from Genesis to Revelation. Encountering the Old Testament World helps you understand the cultural context of the ancient civilizations of the Old Testament books. Psalms specifically looks at what this powerful book of poetry shows us about life and our relationship with God. New Testament History & Literature I specifically digs into the Gospels and Acts. Doctrinal Survey I looks at the key principles of Christianity. Hermeneutics gives you the necessary tools to study any book of the Bible effectively.

Spiritual Transformation I takes you through facets of spiritual growth that strengthen your relationship with Jesus Christ. Evangelism & Discipleship provides effective methods to share your faith and help others begin their walk with Christ. Intro to Discipleship develops your disciple-making skills for both 1-on-1 and small group settings. Biblical Communication teaches how to prepare and deliver lessons to various audiences and demographics. Intro to Missions provides a scriptural basis for world evangelism. Cross Cultural Ministry helps you develop intercultural competencies as a Christian leader. Multiplying Jesus Planting Churches studies the biblical and theological premises of church planting and church planting strategies. Field studies are designed to help you find and be involved in practical ministry.

Intro to Apologetics explores concepts and strategies for defending Christianity. **Intro to Biblical Counseling** gives basic concepts and methods for biblical counseling. **Marriage & Family** examines singleness, marriage, and parenting as God has designed.

Academic Research & Writing helps you practice effective research methods and college-level writing. **Intro to Career Development**, designed for our young adult students, walks you through the process of how to find what career is right for you and steps to implement it.
